YOUR ACTION IS NEEDED NOW

The Rampion 2 Windfarm substation is proposed to be at Oakendene, which is the most ecologically damaging site.



The 5 parallel cables would be laid in a 50 metre wide construction route all through the River Adur catchment area around the Cowfold Stream. The trench is not filled in for the whole time that the project takes to complete, minimum 2 years possibly 6. Many oak trees and many metres of dense hedgerow would be removed from this invaluable patchwork of small fields and flood meadows. Carbon storage lost, nesting sites and established wildlife corridors lost.



Under threat: nightingale and turtle dove nesting and feeding sites, cuckoos, adders, grass snakes, crested newts, long established meadows plants, badger paths, purple hairstreak butterflies, grasshoppers, hunting grounds of little owls, barn owls, red kites, bats, stoats and much more
